A bill to divide this state into 16 congressional districts; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and officers; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This state is divided into 16 congressional dis2 tricts pursuant to the ratio of representation fixed under an act
