THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 13305, 13306, 13308, 13310, 13311, and
- 2 13322 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections

- 4 333.13322 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as

- 6 Sec. 13305. A person shall not engage in the operation of

- 13 No. $\frac{-327}{}$ 207 of the Public Acts of $\frac{-1947}{}$ 1941, being section
- 14 -29.210b- 29.5I of the Michigan Compiled Laws, -shall apply
- 15 APPLIES.
- 16 Sec. 13311. A class IV installation in which no class I,
- 17 H. or III solvents FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS as defined in SECTION 1 OF
- 18 THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE, Act No. -327 207 of the Public Acts of
- 19 1947, as amended 1941, being sections 29.201 to 29.330
- 20 SECTION 29.1 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are employed for
- 21 other than spotting purposes may be installed in a building
- 22 approved by the department.
- 23 Sec. 13322. The department shall promulgate rules necessary
- 24 to carry out this part, and may appoint an advisory committee to
- 25 assist in rule development. The rules shall include the
- 26 following: -license fees, renewal fees, plans, drawings,
- 27 specifications, construction and installation

- 2 (B) DRAWINGS.
