

HOUSE BILL No. 4913

June 5, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Yokich and Profit and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend sections 2 and 3 of Act No. 105 of the Public Acts of 1951, entitled

"An act regulating the erection of posters, signs and placards on any state, public or privately owned lands; and to prescribe penalties for violations of this act,"

being sections 752.822 and 752.823 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 2 and 3 of Act No. 105 of the Public
2 Acts of 1951, being sections 752.822 and 752.823 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 2. All prosecutions under this act shall be in the
5 name of the people of the state of Michigan, and shall be brought
6 before ~~a justice of the peace, police magistrate, or other~~ THE
7 DISTRICT OR MUNICIPAL court of ~~competent jurisdiction in the~~
8 ~~county~~ THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT OR MUNICIPALITY in which the

1 offense was committed, and within 1 year from the time the
2 offense charged was committed.

3 Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of all prosecuting attorneys
4 of this state in their respective counties to see that the provi-
5 sions hereof are enforced and to prosecute all persons charged
6 with violating the provisions hereof; but prosecutions ~~before a~~
7 ~~justice of the peace~~ on the complaint of any such owner, lessee,
8 or agent may be made without complaint, permit, or consent of the
9 prosecuting attorney.
