- 1 (c) His THE SUPPLEMENTAL MEMBER'S last 3 years of credited 2 service are covered service.
- 3 (d) He THE SUPPLEMENTAL MEMBER files a written request for
- 4 retirement with the retirement board stating the date that he OR

- 6 more than 90 days after the date -his- THE application is filed.
- 7 (2) A supplemental member may be separated from employment
