

# HOUSE BILL No. 4966

June 17, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Nye, Oxender, Keith, Emerson, Middaugh, Hoekman, Gnodtke, Fitzgerald, Bartnik, Griffin, London, Martin, Jondahl, Bender, Jaye, Dalman, Munsell, DeLange, Alley, Scott, Walberg, Van Singel, Hoffman, Profit, Gilmer, Dolan, Harder, Perry Bullard, Strand and Middleton and referred to the Committee on Taxation.

A bill to repeal certain acts and parts of acts on a specific date.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

26 constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1 of article XII of  
27 the state constitution of 1963.
