- 4 SEC. 464B. (1) THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A PUBLIC ENTERTAIN-
- 5 MENT FACILITY SHALL NOT OFFER OR SELL FESTIVAL SEATING ADMISSION
- 6 TO THAT PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY.
- 7 (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:
- 8 (A) "FESTIVAL SEATING" MEANS GENERAL ADMISSION WITHOUT
- 9 DESIGNATED SEATING.

- 1 (B) "PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY" MEANS THE SITUS OF AN
- 2 ENTERTAINMENT EVENT THAT PROVIDES SEATING FOR THE PUBLIC AND IS

- 4 (i) AN AUDITORIUM.
- 5 (ii) AN ARENA.
- 6 (iii) A THEATER.
- 7 (iv) A MUSEUM.
- 8 (ν) A CONCERT HALL.
- (vi) ANY OTHER PLACE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC DURING THE PERIOD OF
- 10 ITS USE FOR A PERFORMANCE OR EXHIBIT OF THE ARTS.
- 11 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
- 12 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS.
