

# HOUSE BILL No. 4998

June 26, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Owen, Bartnik, DeMars, Jacobetti, Mathieu, Bennett, Kosteva, Porreca, Rocca, Griffin and Jonker and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to provide for a type I transfer of the Michigan veterans' facility in Grand Rapids and the D.J. Jacobetti Michigan veterans' facility in Marquette from the department of public health to the department of military affairs.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1. Effective September 1, 1991, the Michigan veterans'  
2 facility in Grand Rapids and the D.J. Jacobetti Michigan  
3 veterans' facility in Marquette are transferred from the depart-  
4 ment of public health to the department of military affairs by a  
5 type I transfer as defined in section 3 of the executive organi-  
6 zation act of 1965, Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, being  
7 section 16.103 of the Michigan Compiled Laws. The Michigan  
8 veterans' facility in Grand Rapids and the D.J. Jacobetti  
9 Michigan veterans' facility in Marquette shall exercise their  
10 prescribed statutory powers, duties, and functions of

1 rule-making, licensing, and registration including the  
2 prescription of rules, rates, regulations and standards, and  
3 adjudication and other powers and duties as prescribed in Act  
4 No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1885, being sections 36.1 to 36.12  
5 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, Act No. 15 of the Public Acts of  
6 1921, being sections 36.31 to 36.32 of the Michigan Compiled  
7 Laws, Act No. 90 of the Public Acts of 1895, being sections 36.42  
8 to 36.43 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, Act No. 54 of the Public  
9 Acts of 1901, being sections 36.51 to 36.55 of the Michigan  
10 Compiled Laws, and Act No. 313 of the Public Acts of 1905, being  
11 section 36.61 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, independently of the  
12 head of the department of military affairs. All budgeting, pro-  
13 curement, and related management functions of the Michigan  
14 veterans' facility in Grand Rapids and the D.J. Jacobetti  
15 Michigan veterans' facility in Marquette shall be performed under  
16 the direction and supervision of the head of the department of  
17 military affairs. The commandants of the Michigan veterans'  
18 facility in Grand Rapids and the D.J. Jacobetti Michigan  
19 veterans' facility in Marquette shall report to the board of man-  
20 agers and the board of managers shall report to the head of the  
21 department of military affairs. All records, personnel, proper-  
22 ty, and unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, and  
23 other funds used, held, employed, available, or to be made avail-  
24 able to the department of public health for the activities trans-  
25 ferred to the department of military affairs are transferred to  
26 the department of military affairs.
