HOUSE BILL No. 5082

August 1, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Bodem, DeMars and McBryde and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs.

A bill to provide free tuition and fees at state public institutions of higher education for Michigan veterans of the Persian Gulf War; and to provide for an appropriation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "Persian Gulf veterans tuition act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Department" means the department of military affairs.
- (b) "Michigan Persian Gulf veteran" means a resident of this
- 6 state who served on active duty in the United States armed
- 7 forces, Michigan national guard, or United States armed forces
- 8 reserve after August 2, 1990 in an area designated as a combat
- 9 zone by the President of the United States.
- (c) "State institution of higher education" means a public
- 11 community or junior college established under section 7 of

- 1 article VIII of the state constitution of 1963 or part 25 of the
- 2 school code of 1976, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976,
- 3 being sections 380.1601 to 380.1607 of the Michigan Compiled
- 4 Laws, or a state university described in section 4, 5, or 6 of
- 5 article VIII of the state constitution of 1963.
- 6 Sec. 3. (1) A state institution of higher education shall
- 7 waive tuition and mandatory fees for each Michigan Persian Gulf
- 8 veteran if he or she meets all of the following requirements:
- 9 (a) Applies and qualifies for admission as a full-time,
- 10 part-time, or summer school student.
- (b) Is a legal resident of the state for not less than the
- 12 12 consecutive months before applying.
- (c) Applies to the department for tuition and fee waiver
- 14 under this act and provides evidence satisfactory to the depart-
- 15 ment that he or she is a Michigan Persian Gulf veteran and that
- 16 he or she meets the other requirements of this section.
- 17 (d) Submits his or her initial application for the waiver to
- 18 the department not later than 5 years after the effective date of
- 19 this act.
- 20 (2) A Michigan Persian Gulf veteran remains eligible for the
- 21 tuition and fee waiver under this act for a period of 5 years
- 22 from the beginning of the term or semester in which he or she

- 24 Sec. 4. Upon application by the institution, the department
- 25 shall reimburse annually each state institution of higher educa-
- 26 tion for the total amount of tuition and fees waived during the
- 27 immediately preceding fiscal year under section 3. The

- 2 individuals for whom tuition and fees have been waived at each
- 3 institution and the total amounts to be paid under this act.
- 4 Sec. 5. The department shall provide the necessary forms
- 5 and applications and shall cooperate with the state institutions
- 6 of higher education in developing efficient procedures for imple-
- 7 menting this act.
- 8 Sec. 6. The legislature shall appropriate annually the
- 9 funds necessary to implement this act.
