## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of 1967, as
- 2 amended, being sections 206.1 to 206.532 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended by adding section 265 to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 265. (1) A TAXPAYER, OTHER THAN AN ESTATE OR A TRUST,
- 5 MAY CREDIT AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS ACT FOR THE TAXABLE
- 6 YEAR THE AMOUNT THAT THE COST PAID BY THE TAXPAYER TO PURCHASE A
- 7 FAMILY BASIC HEALTH POLICY OR \$1,200.00, WHICHEVER IS LESS, OR AN
- 8 INDIVIDUAL BASIC HEALTH POLICY OR \$900.00, WHICHEVER IS LESS,

- 1 EXCEEDS 6% OF THE TAXPAYER'S ADJUSTED GROSS INCOME FOR THAT
- 2 TAXABLE YEAR.
- 3 (2) A TAXPAYER WHO IS MARRIED SHALL FILE A JOINT RETURN TO
- 4 BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION EXCEPT THAT IF A
