- 6 CHAPTER MAY CLAIM A CREDIT AGAINST THE TAX EQUAL TO 1.33% OF THE
- 7 INSURER'S GROSS RECEIPTS FROM BASIC HEALTH POLICIES OR
- 8 CERTIFICATES OFFERED PURSUANT TO SECTION 3406F.
