- 7 SUBSCRIBER'S HEALTH MAINTENANCE CONTRACT UNTIL DECEMBER 31 OF THE
- 8 CALENDAR YEAR IN WHICH THE CHILD BECOMES 25 YEARS OF AGE
- 9 REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT THE CHILD IS CONSIDERED A DEPENDENT
