## **HOUSE BILL No. 5107**

September 11, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Bobier, Hickner, DeBeaussaert, Olshove, Kosteva, Randall, Middaugh, Fitzgerald and Brackenridge and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Manistee county; and to prescribe conditions for the conveyance.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, may convey to the county board of commissioners for the
- 3 county of Manistee, for consideration of \$1.00, property located
- 4 in the township of Manistee, Manistee county, Michigan, and
- 5 described as follows:
- 6 A 66.0 foot wide strip of land 33.0 feet each side of a cen-
- 7 terline described as commencing at the Northeast corner of
- 8 Section Eight (8), Township Twenty-one (21) North, Range Sixteen
- 9 (16) West, Manistee County, Michigan; thence South 89 degrees
- 10 26'13" West 694.38 feet, on the North line of said Section Eight
- 11 (8) to the point of beginning of said centerline; thence South 04

- 1 degrees 11'26" East 1210.53 feet, to a point of ending on the
- 2 South line of the North one half (N1/2) of the Northeast Quarter
- 3 (NE1/4) of said Section Eight (8). The side lines of said 66.0
- 4 foot wide strip shall be shortened or lengthened to meet the
- 5 parent parcel property lines.
- 6 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by this act shall provide
- 7 that the land shall be used exclusively for a roadway and that
- 8 upon termination of this use, or upon use for any other purpose,
- 9 title to the property shall revert immediately to the state, with
- 10 the state assuming no liability for improvements made at the
- 11 grantee's expense.
- 12 Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by
- 13 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general and shall reserve
- 14 to the state all rights to coal, oil, gas, and other minerals
- 15 found on, within, or under the property conveyed, excluding sand,
- 16 gravel, clay, or other non-metallic minerals.
- 17 Sec. 4. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 18 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
