## **HOUSE BILL No. 5126**

September 12, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Profit, Hertel and DeMars and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend sections 6 and 7 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended "Michigan vehicle code,"

section 6 as amended by Act No. 188 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sections 257.6 and 257.7 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

- (A) A person who <del>drives</del> OPERATES a motor vehicle <del>while in</del>
