HOUSE BILL No. 5131

September 17, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Rocca and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend section 10 of Act No. 149 of the Public Acts of 1960, entitled

"An act to authorize the state conservation commission to acquire land and undertake an improvement program at certain state parks; to provide for financing through the issuance of revenue bonds; to provide the terms, conditions and limitations on such bonds; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state officers; to authorize the imposition of certain charges and fees for the payment and security of such bonds and for other purposes; to authorize the refunding of such bonds; and to prescribe penalties for violations of this act,"

as amended by Act No. 177 of the Public Acts of 1989, being section 318.310 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 10 of Act No. 149 of the Public Acts of 2 1960, as amended by Act No. 177 of the Public Acts of 1989, being 3 section 318.310 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read

- 1 Sec. 10. (1) The commission may require park permits and 2 impose and collect park permit fees for entry into a state park 3 or portion of a state park posted in the manner prescribed by 4 this act. The commission shall prepare and distribute suitable
- 5 park permits to carry out this act.
- 6 (2) Except as otherwise provided in this section, UPON
 7 RECEIPT OF AN ANNUAL PERMIT FEE THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE an
 8 annual park permit shall be issued and shall authorize the
 9 entry of the A motor vehicle to which it THAT PERMIT is originally attached within the confines of any INTO A state park or
 11 recreation area during the calendar year in which THAT PERMIT WAS
 12 issued. The fee for the annual park permit shall be IS \$15.00
 13 in 1990, 1991, and 1992, \$18.00 in 1993 and 1994, and \$20.00 in
 14 1995 and thereafter, except that THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE TO an
 15 owner of a resident motor vehicle who is 65 years of age or
 16 older —, shall be issued a special annual park permit for 1/4
 17 the amount of the annual park permit.
- 18 (3) A THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE A daily park permit,

 19 valid for 1 day only, shall be issued for a fee to be fixed by

 20 the commission, but in an amount not to exceed \$4.00 for resident

 21 motor vehicles and \$6.00 for nonresident motor vehicles. The

 22 COMMISSION MAY CHARGE A fee for nonresident motor vehicles may

 23 be OF \$4.00 in all parks except where nonresident day use is

 24 extremely high. The commission shall identify parks where non
 25 resident day use is extremely high and set the nonresident fee at

 26 \$6.00. The daily permit shall authorize AUTHORIZES the entry

- 3 (4) FOR EACH MOTOR VEHICLE BEING TOWED INTO A STATE PARK OR

- 12 (5) -(4) A resident AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 13 (A) "RECREATIONAL VEHICLE" MEANS A TRANSPORTABLE STRUCTURE
- 14 THAT IS USED FOR CAMPING OR CASUAL TRAVEL.
- (B) "RESIDENT motor vehicle" is MEANS a vehicle that is
- 16 registered as a motor vehicle in this state.
- 17 (6) (5) This act shall apply APPLIES only to the entry
- 18 of motor vehicles into -the state parks and to -the park per-
- 19 mits authorized in this act and -shall DOES not obviate the
- 20 necessity of obtaining additional permits for special services or
- 21 park privileges as previously or subsequently THAT HAVE BEEN OR
- 22 may be required by law or by -rules A RULE promulgated by the
- 23 commission. The director of the department of natural
- 24 resources shall designate each person, partnership, or corpora-
- 25 tion in the state authorized to sell park permits and shall
- 26 require as a condition of the designation that a surety bond be
- 27 furnished in an amount and in a form and with the surety as

- 1 shall be acceptable to the director OF THE DEPARTMENT. A
- 2 AFTER BEING DESIGNATED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT, A
- 3 person, partnership, or corporation -so-designated by the direc-
- 4 tor of the department of natural resources after being
- 5 designated may issue park permits in accordance with this act.
- 6 (7) -(6) Commercial motor coaches or vans are A COMMERCIAL
- 7 MOTOR COACH OR VAN WITH A CAPACITY OF MORE THAN 12 PASSENGERS IS
- 8 not eligible to enter a state park with an annual park permit.
- 9 The commission of natural resources may establish a daily fee not
- 10 to exceed \$15.00 to allow A commercial motor -coaches COACH or
- 11 -vans VAN with a capacity of over 12 passengers daily entry into 12 a state park.
- 13 (8) -(7) The department of natural resources may add to
- 14 the cost of a reservation or for payment for a motor vehicle
- 15 entrance or camping fee the charges that the state incurs because
- 16 of PAYMENT OF the COST OR FEE BY use of a credit card.
