A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Leelanau county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for the disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, may convey to Bingham township, for \$1.00, certain prop-
- 3 erty now under the jurisdiction of the department of mental
- 4 health and located in Bingham township, Leelanau county, and more
- 5 specifically described as follows:
- 6 All of Government Lot Three (3) of Section Twenty-eight (28)
- 7 in Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Eleven (11) West, lying
- 8 South of the East and West Highway, and East of the North and
- 9 South Highway, Section Twenty-eight (28) Township Twenty-nine

- 1 (29) North, Range Eleven (11) West, according to the United 2 States Survey thereof.
- Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by section 1 shall pro-
- 4 vide that the property conveyed shall be used for the purpose of
- 5 a public park, and that upon termination of that use, or upon use
- 6 for any other purpose, title to the property shall revert immedi-
- 7 ately to the state, with the state assuming no liability for any
- 8 improvements made by Bingham township.
- 9 Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by section 1 shall be by
- 10 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general, and shall
- 11 reserve to the state all rights to oil, coal, gas, or other mate-
- 12 rials, excluding sand, gravel, clay, or other nonmetallic miner-
- 13 als found on, within, or under the conveyed land.
- 14 Sec. 4. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 15 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
