

HOUSE BILL No. 5181

September 26, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Bennane, Rocca, Gire, Barns, Hunter, DeMars, Yokich, Varga and Gubow and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended "Public health code," as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding sections 21133 and 21135.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
2 amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding sections 21133 and 21135 to
4 read as follows:

5 SEC. 21133. THE EMS-TRAUMA CARE SYSTEMS TRUST FUND IS CRE-
6 ATED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY, AND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED
7 BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH. THE FUND IS CAPITALIZED BY
8 REVENUES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 806 OF THE MICHIGAN
9 VEHICLE CODE, ACT NO. 300 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1949, BEING

1 SECTION 257.806 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. THE FUND SHALL
2 ADDITIONALLY RECEIVE MONEY AS PROVIDED IN THIS PART AND AS OTHER-
3 WISE PROVIDED BY LAW, AND SHALL RECEIVE ANY GIFTS OR CONTRIBU-
4 TIONS TO THE FUND.

5 SEC. 21135. (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE
6 INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT THE
7 INTEREST AND EARNINGS OF THE FUND TO THE FUND. THE STATE TREA-
8 SURER SHALL RETAIN THE MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE
9 FISCAL YEAR AND SHALL NOT RETURN THAT MONEY TO THE GENERAL FUND.

10 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL EXPEND THE MONEY IN THE FUND ONLY
11 IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

12 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE 20% OF THE MONEY IN
13 THE FUND FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, DEVELOPMENT, EXPANSION, AND
14 IMPROVEMENT OF MEDICAL CONTROL AUTHORITIES AND TRAUMA CARE SYS-
15 TEMS WITHIN THE STATE. IF SUFFICIENT FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE, THE
16 DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE NOT LESS THAN \$250,000.00 ANNU-
17 ALLY TO EACH REGIONAL TRAUMA AUTHORITY ESTABLISHED AS A PILOT
18 PROJECT PURSUANT TO SECTION 21113.

19 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE 50% OF THE MONEY IN
20 THE FUND TO MATCH NEW COUNTY, MUNICIPAL, AND PRIVATE EMERGENCY
21 MEDICAL SERVICES APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENT
22 OF THOSE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES APPROVED BY THE MEDICAL CON-
23 TROL AUTHORITY.

24 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE 20% OF THE MONEY IN
25 THE FUND FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, EXPANSION, AND IMPROVEMENT OF
26 NONURBANIZED AREA EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES. FOR PURPOSES OF

1 THIS SECTION, "NONURBANIZED AREA" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
2 SECTION 21551.

3 (D) TEN PERCENT OF THE MONEY IN THE FUND SHALL BE AVAILABLE
4 FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE ASSOCIATED
5 WITH THE COLLECTION OF THE EMS-TRAUMA CARE SYSTEMS TRUST FUND
6 SURCHARGE PURSUANT TO SECTION 806 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE,
7 ACT NO. 300 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1949, BEING SECTION 257.806 OF
8 THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

9 (3) MONEY IN THE FUND SHALL NOT BE EXPENDED OR ALLOCATED FOR
10 THE REDUCTION, SUBSTITUTION, OR REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING COUNTY OR
11 MUNICIPAL FUNDS OR STATE GENERAL FUNDS.

12 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
13 all of the following bills of the 86th Legislature are enacted
14 into law:
