

HOUSE BILL No. 5203

October 1, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Kosteva, Gubow, DeMars, Dobronski, Gire, Olshove, Weeks, Profit and Wozniak and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, entitled as amended

"Of the powers and duties of townships, the election and duties of township officers, and the division of townships,"

as amended, being sections 41.1a to 41.110c of the Michigan

Compiled Laws, by adding section 83b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, as
2 amended, being sections 41.1a to 41.110c of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 83b to read as follows:

4 SEC. 83B. (1) A CONSTABLE OR POLICE OFFICER OF A TOWNSHIP
5 HAS THE SAME AUTHORITY AS A DEPUTY SHERIFF TO EXECUTE A CIVIL
6 BENCH WARRANT ISSUED BY THE CIRCUIT COURT THAT ARISES OUT OF A
7 DOMESTIC RELATIONS MATTER.

1 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DOMESTIC RELATIONS MATTER"
2 MEANS A CIRCUIT COURT PROCEEDING THAT ARISES OUT OF LITIGATION
3 UNDER EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

4 (A) THE PATERNITY ACT, ACT NO. 205 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF
5 1956, BEING SECTIONS 722.711 TO 722.730 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED
6 LAWS.

7 (B) A LAW OF THIS STATE REGARDING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

8 (i) CHILD CUSTODY OR VISITATION.

9 (ii) CHILD SUPPORT, OR SPOUSE OR FORMER SPOUSE SUPPORT.

10 (iii) ANY INJUNCTIVE OR RESTRAINING ORDER ISSUED BY THE CIR-
11 CUIT COURT THAT RESTRAINS OR ENJOINS A SPOUSE, A FORMER SPOUSE,
12 OR A PERSON RESIDING OR HAVING RESIDED IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD AS
13 THE VICTIM FROM ENTERING ONTO PREMISES, FROM ASSAULTING, BEATING,
14 MOLESTING, OR WOUNDING A NAMED PERSON, OR FROM REMOVING MINOR
15 CHILDREN FROM THE PERSON HAVING LEGAL CUSTODY OF THE CHILDREN.
