- 5 SEC. 17251. (1) THE OFFICE OF NURSING IS CREATED IN THE
- 6 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH. THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HEALTH SHALL
- 7 APPOINT A DIRECTOR FOR THE OFFICE OF NURSING.
- 8 (2) THE OFFICE OF NURSING SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 14 (3) THE OFFICE OF NURSING IS FUNDED BY THE HEALTH PROFES-
- 15 SIONS REGULATORY FUND AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 3(8) OF THE STATE
- 16 LICENSE FEE ACT, ACT NO. 152 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1979, BEING
