

HOUSE BILL No. 5257

October 14, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Harder, Dalman, DeMars, Leland, Perry Bullard, Jonker, Goss, Barns, Dobronski, Wallace, Olshove and Baade and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 271 of the Public Acts of 1913, entitled as amended

"An act to create the Michigan historical commission; to provide for the appointment of members of the commission; to fix their terms of office, prescribe their powers and duties; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officers; to make an appropriation to carry out the provisions of this act; to provide for the distribution of certain revenue; to provide for the listing and destruction of useless documents, books and papers; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith,"

being section 399.1 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 271 of the Public Acts of
2 1913, being section 399.1 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1. (1) There is hereby created a commission to be
5 known as the Michigan historical commission. ~~Said~~ THE MICHIGAN
6 HISTORICAL commission shall consist of 6 members, with the

1 addition of the governor, ex-officio. ~~by said~~ THE 6 members OF
2 THE COMMISSION shall be appointed by the governor ~~by and~~ with
3 the advice and consent of the senate. ~~No member~~ MEMBERS of
4 ~~said~~ THE commission shall NOT receive any compensation for
5 ~~his~~ THEIR services, except actual and necessary expenses while
6 attending the meetings or carrying out the purposes of ~~said~~ THE
7 commission.

8 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION APPOINTED
9 UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE MACKINAC ISLAND
10 STATE PARK COMMISSION PURSUANT TO SECTION 2 OF ACT NO. 355 OF THE
11 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1927, BEING SECTION 318.62 OF THE MICHIGAN
12 COMPILED LAWS, SHALL BE A NONVOTING MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION AND
13 SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION. EXPENSES SHALL BE REIMBURSED
14 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1).
