

HOUSE BILL No. 5259

October 14, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Harder, Leland, DeMars, Dalman, Perry Bullard, Bankes, Jonker, Goss, Varga, Barns, Dobronski, Wallace, Olshove and Baade and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"The school code of 1976,"

as amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 1166a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
2 amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1166a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 1166A. A K-12 SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL REQUIRE IN HIGH
6 SCHOOL A 1-SEMESTER COURSE OF STUDY OF 5 PERIODS PER WEEK IN
7 MICHIGAN HISTORY. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL NOT ISSUE A DIPLOMA
8 TO A PUPIL WHO HAS NOT SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THIS COURSE. THIS
9 REQUIREMENT IS NOT APPLICABLE AS A GRADUATION REQUIREMENT FOR A

1 HIGH SCHOOL PUPIL WHO HAS ENLISTED OR BEEN INDUCTED INTO MILITARY
2 SERVICE.
