## **HOUSE BILL No. 5260**

October 14, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Harder, DeMars, Dalman, Leland, Perry Bullard, Bankes, Jonker, Goss, Barns, Dobronski, Wallace, Olshove and Baade and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 355 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled

"An act to provide for the appointment of a board of commissioners who shall have the management and control of the Mackinac Island state park, defining its powers and duties; and to repeal Act No. 222 of the Public Acts of 1895,"

being section 318.62 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 355 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1927, being section 318.62 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 2. (1) Within 15 days after the passage of this act
- 5 the governor shall appoint 7 commissioners, who shall be citizens
- 6 of, registered voters, and regularly domiciled in this state and
- 7 who shall hereafter constitute a board of commissioners to be
- 8 known as the Mackinac Island state park commission. -:

- 1 Provided, That the present commissioners shall hold office until
- 2 their successors have been appointed. One commissioner shall be
- 3 known as the "resident commissioner," and -said commissioner
- 4 shall be a legal resident of the island MACKINAC ISLAND and a
- 5 property owner in the city of Mackinac Island for a period of not
- 6 less than 6 months preceding his OR HER nomination. One commis-
- 7 sioner shall be a resident of the village of Mackinaw City. His
- 8 OR HER term of office shall commence on April 12, 1958.
- 9 (2) Said THE commissioners shall be appointed by the gov-
- 10 ernor, -by and with the advice and consent of the senate, for
- 11 terms of 6 years each and shall hold office until their succes-
- 12 sors are appointed. -- Provided, That of the THE members
- 13 -first SHALL BE appointed -- SO THAT 2 -shall be ARE appointed
- 14 for a term of 2 years, 2 for a term of 4 years each, and 2 for a
- 15 term of 6 years each. -: Provided further, That not NOT more
- 16 than 4 commissioners at any one time shall be MEMBERS of the
- 17 same political party. Vacancies shall be filled by the governor
- 18 in the same manner as the original appointment for the unexpired
- 19 term. No member MEMBERS of the board shall NOT receive any
- 20 compensation for -his THEIR services as -commissioner, but
- 21 COMMISSIONERS. HOWEVER, each commissioner shall receive his BE
- 22 REIMBURSED FOR HIS OR HER actual disbursement for his expense
- 23 AND NECESSARY EXPENSES incurred in connection with the
- 24 PERFORMANCE OF HIS OR HER duties of his office, which expense
- 25 shall be allowed and paid by the auditor general upon SUBMISSION
- 26 OF A proper vouchers therefor VOUCHER TO THE AUDITOR GENERAL.

- 1 (3) The commission shall annually elect a -chairman,
- 2 vice chairman CHAIRPERSON, VICE-CHAIRPERSON, and secretary.
- 3 (4) IN ADDITION TO THE COMMISSIONERS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO
- 4 SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2), THE FOLLOWING PERSONS SHALL BE NONVOTING
- 5 MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION WHO SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION
- 6 BUT WHO MAY BE REIMBURSED FOR THEIR EXPENSES UNDER SUBSECTION
- 7 (2):
- 8 (A) THE DIRECTOR OF THE BUREAU OF HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT
- 9 OF STATE.
- 10 (B) THE PRESIDENT OF THE MICHIGAN HISTORICAL COMMISSION.
