

HOUSE BILL No. 5360

December 3, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Profit and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 539d of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

being section 750.539d of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 539d of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts
2 of 1931, being section 750.539d of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 539d. ~~Any~~ A person who installs ~~in any private~~
5 ~~place, without the consent of the person or persons entitled to~~
6 ~~privacy there,~~ any device for observing, photographing, or
7 eavesdropping upon the sounds or events in ~~such place~~ A PRIVATE
8 PLACE WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE PERSON OR PERSONS ENTITLED TO
9 PRIVACY IN THAT PLACE, or WHO uses ~~any such~~ THAT unauthorized
10 installation, is guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment

1 ~~in a state prison~~ for not more than 2 years or by a fine of not
2 more than \$2,000.00, or both.
