## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 107 of Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1939, being section 400.107 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 107. (1) In establishing financial eligibility for
- 5 the medically indigent as defined in section  $\frac{-106}{(2)}$  106(1)(B)
- 6 income shall be disregarded in accordance with standards estab-
- 7 lished for the related categorical assistance program.
- 8 Additional income shall be applied against BOTH OF THE
- 9 FOLLOWING:

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- 1 (A) -(i) the THE cost of medical care not authorized under 2 this act. -, and (ii) the
- 3 (B) THE cost of services authorized under this act, in 4 excess of the basic amount.
- 5 (2) For medical assistance only, income shall include the
- 6 amount of contribution -which THAT an estranged spouse or parent
- 7 for a minor child is making to the applicant according to the
- 8 standards of the state department, or pursuant to a court deter-
- 9 mination, if there is such a determination. Nothing in this
- 10 section shall eliminate the responsibility of support established
- 11 in section 76 for cash assistance received under this act.
- 12 (3) IN ESTABLISHING FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY FOR THE MEDICALLY
- 13 INDIGENT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 106(1)(B), THE STATE DEPARTMENT
- 14 SHALL NOT TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE INCOME AND RESOURCES OF ANY
- 15 PERSON OTHER THAN THE FOLLOWING:
- 16 (A) THE APPLICANT.
- 17 (B) THE SPOUSE OF THE APPLICANT.
- 18 (C) THE PARENT OR PARENTS OF AN APPLICANT WHO IS UNDER AGE
- 19 21, OR WHO IS OVER AGE 21 AND BLIND OR DISABLED.
