THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 19b of Act No. 240 of the Public Acts of 2 1943, as added by Act No. 62 of the Public Acts of 1991, being
- 3 section 38.19b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
- 4 as follows:
- Sec. 19b. (1) Notwithstanding section 19, a member may
- 6 retire and, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), receive a
- 7 retirement allowance computed under section 20(1) if the member
- 8 meets all of the following requirements:

- 1 (a) On the effective date of his or her retirement, the
- 2 member has met the service requirements to receive a retirement
- 3 allowance under this act, the member's combined age and amount of
- 4 credited service is equal to or greater than 70 years, and the
- 5 member is 50 years of age or older.
- 6 (b) The member was employed by this state for the 6-month
- 7 period ending on the effective date of his or her retirement. A
- 8 member who was restored to active service during that 6-month
- 9 period under section 33 or a member who is on layoff status from
- 10 state employment is considered to have met the employment
- 11 requirement of this subdivision.
- (c) The member files a written application with the retire-
- 13 ment board, on or after September 1, 1991, but not later than
- 14 March 1, 1992, stating a date, which date shall be 30 to 90 days
- 15 after the execution and filing of the application but not later
- 16 than April 1, 1992, on which he or she desires to retire.
- 17 (2) A SUPPLEMENTAL MEMBER, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 45, MAY
- 18 RETIRE UNDER THIS SECTION AND RECEIVE A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE COM-

- 22 (3) -(2) Any amount that a member retiring under this sec-
- 23 tion would otherwise be entitled to receive in a lump sum at
- 24 retirement on account of accumulated sick leave shall be paid in
- 25 60 consecutive equal monthly installments.
