- 8 (A) TAKE GAME, OTHER THAN FUR-BEARING ANIMALS, AND DETACH OR
- 9 REMOVE THE HEAD, HIDE, CLAWS, TEETH, ANTLERS, FEATHERS, INTERNAL

- 1 ORGANS, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THE ABOVE FROM THE GAME WITH THE
- 2 INTENT TO ABANDON THE REMAINDER OF THE CARCASS OR BODY.
- (B) TAKE ANY GAME AND ABANDON THE BODY WITHOUT MAKING A REA-3
- 4 SONABLE ATTEMPT TO RETRIEVE THE BODY.
- (C) TAKE ANY GAME, OTHER THAN FUR-BEARING ANIMALS, AND ABAN-5
