

HOUSE BILL No. 5528

February 18, 1992, Introduced by Rep. O'Neill and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make and adjust appropriations for the department of education for certain purposes for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of education to
2 supplement former appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30,
3 1992, from the following funds:

16 GENERAL SECTIONS

17 Sec. 201. (1) In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
18 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending in
19 this appropriation act is (\$585,400.00) and state appropriations to be
20 paid to local units of government in section 101 are \$0.

21 (2) When it appears to the principal executive officer of each
22 department that state spending to local units of government will be less
23 than the amount that was projected to be expended for any quarter, the
24 principal executive officer shall immediately give notice of the
25 appropriate shortfall to the department of management and budget, the

1 senate and house appropriations committees, and the senate and house
2 fiscal agencies.

3 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under
4 this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and
5 programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to
6 the management and budget act, Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984,
7 being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

8 Sec. 203. The negative amount specified in section 101 for execu-
9 tive director programs shall be deducted from the amount appropriated for
10 executive director programs in Act No. 126 of the Public Acts of 1991.
