

HOUSE BILL No. 5538

February 19, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Byrum, Bartnik, Gire, Saunders, Joe Young, Jr., Weeks, Harder, DeMars and Stallworth and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend section 606 of Act No. 86 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled

"The hunting and fishing license act,"

as added by Act No. 63 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 316.606 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 606 of Act No. 86 of the Public Acts of
2 1980, as added by Act No. 63 of the Public Acts of 1986, being
3 section 316.606 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 606. (1) The department may sell, or contract for the
6 sale of, license application lists or information filed with the
7 department pursuant to this act and related publications of the
8 department. The department shall establish the price for the
9 lists, information, and publications and the proceeds of all

1 sales pursuant to this section shall be credited to the game and
2 fish protection fund in the manner prescribed in section 601.

3 (2) HOWEVER, THE NAME OF A LICENSEE OR AN APPLICANT FOR A
4 LICENSE SHALL NOT BE SOLD FOR PURPOSES OF COMMERCIAL SOLICITATION
5 OR ANY COMMERCIAL PURPOSE WITHOUT THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE
6 LICENSEE OR APPLICANT.
