- 1 equipped. A PERSON SHALL NOT RIDE AS A PASSENGER ON A MOTORCYCLE

- 3 (3) A moped shall not be used to carry more than 1 person at 4 a time.
- 5 (4) A person operating or riding on a motorcycle, and any
- 6 person less than 19 years of age operating a moped on a public
