

# HOUSE BILL No. 5610

March 4, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Perry Bullard, Nye and Strand and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 28 of chapter 84 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, entitled

"Of divorce,"

being section 552.28 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 28 of chapter 84 of the Revised Statutes  
2 of 1846, being section 552.28 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4       Sec. 28. ~~After~~ ON PETITION OF EITHER PARTY, AFTER a judg-  
5 ment for alimony or other allowance ~~—~~ for either party ~~and~~  
6 ~~children, or any of them, and also~~ OR A CHILD, OR after a judg-  
7 ment for the appointment of trustees ~~—~~ to receive and hold  
8 ~~any~~ property for the use of either party or ~~children as before~~  
9 ~~provided~~ A CHILD, AND SUBJECT TO SECTION 17, the court may ~~—~~  
10 ~~from time to time, on the petition of either of the parties,~~

1 revise and alter ~~such~~ THE judgment, respecting the amount OR  
2 PAYMENT of ~~such~~ THE alimony or allowance, ~~and the payment~~  
3 ~~thereof,~~ and also respecting the appropriation and payment of  
4 the principal and income of the property ~~so~~ held in trust, and  
5 may make any judgment respecting any of the matters ~~which such~~  
6 THAT THE court might have made in the original ~~suit~~ ACTION.
