

HOUSE BILL No. 5627

March 5, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Yokich, Profit, Allen, Rocca, DeMars, Harrison, Joe Young, Sr., Gubow, Bennane, Byrum, Dobronski, Johnson, Kilpatrick, Stallworth, Murphy, Joe Young, Jr., Varga, Wozniak, Dolan, Jondahl, Palamara, Niederstadt and Gire and referred to the Committee on Colleges and Universities.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 75 of the Public Acts of 1974, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for payment to approved independent nonprofit institutions of higher education, located within the state, for all earned degrees conferred upon Michigan residents; and to provide for appropriations,"

as amended by Act No. 9 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 390.1022 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 75 of the Public Acts of
2 1974, as amended by Act No. 9 of the Public Acts of 1984, being
3 section 390.1022 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to
4 read as follows:

5 Sec. 2. To qualify for state payments under this act, an
6 independent nonprofit institution of higher education shall MEET
7 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

1 (a) Be incorporated under Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of
2 1931, as amended, being sections 450.98 to 450.192 of the
3 Michigan Compiled Laws, or subject to that act without formal
4 organization ~~thereunder~~ UNDER THAT ACT.

5 (b) Submit annually to the state board of education reports
6 ~~which~~ THAT are required and necessary to administer this act.

7 (c) Maintain for 3 years and make available for inspection
8 records necessary for conducting an audit and for administration
9 of this act.

10 (d) File with the state board of education a certificate of
11 assurance of compliance with title 6 of the civil rights act of
12 1964, Public Law 88-352, 78 Stat. 241, as in effect on January
13 1, 1966.

14 (E) COMPLY WITH THE MICHIGAN CAMPUS SEXUAL ASSAULT VICTIMS'
15 BILL OF RIGHTS ACT.

16 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
17 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 5624 (request
18 no. 04665'91) of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
