

HOUSE BILL No. 5630

March 5, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Yokich, Profit, Allen, DeMars, Rocca, Gubow, Bennane, Byrum, Dobronski, Johnson, Kilpatrick, Stallworth, Murphy, Harrison, Joe Young, Jr., Varga, Wozniak, Dolan, Jondahl, Palamara, Niederstadt and Gire and referred to the Committee on Colleges and Universities.

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of 1986, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible graduate and professional graduate schools and employed by qualified employers; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies; and to provide for an appropriation,"

being section 390.1323 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of
2 1986, being section 390.1323 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3. (1) A recognized graduate or professional graduate
5 school in this state is eligible to participate in the program if
6 the graduate or professional graduate school ~~is~~ MEETS ALL OF
7 THE FOLLOWING:

1 (A) IS a degree-granting institution approved by the state
2 board of education. ~~the~~

3 (B) ITS instructional programs are not comprised solely of
4 sectarian instruction or religious worship. ~~and the school~~
5 ~~participates~~

6 (C) PARTICIPATES in the federal work-study program under
7 sections 441 to 448 of title IV of the higher education act of
8 1965, 42 U.S.C. 2751 to 2756b.

9 (D) IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE MICHIGAN CAMPUS SEXUAL ASSAULT
10 VICTIMS' BILL OF RIGHTS ACT.

11 (2) A participating school, at its option, may offer aca-
12 demic credit to students enrolled in the program.

13 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
14 Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 5624 (request
15 no. 04665'91) of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
