

# HOUSE BILL No. 5631

March 5, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Yokich, Profit, Allen, Joe Young, Sr., DeMars, Rocca, Gubow, Bennane, Byrum, Dobronski, Johnson, Kilpatrick, Stallworth, Murphy, Harrison, Joe Young, Jr., Wozniak, Varga, Dolan, Jondahl, Palamara, Niederstadt and Gire and referred to the Committee on Colleges and Universities.

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 288 of the Public Acts of 1986, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible postsecondary schools and employed by qualified employers; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

being section 390.1373 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 288 of the Public Acts of  
2 1986, being section 390.1373 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3. (1) A recognized postsecondary school in this state  
5 is eligible to participate in the MWS program if the postsecond-  
6 ary school ~~is~~ MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

7 (A) IS a degree-granting institution approved by the state  
8 board of education. ~~the~~

1 (B) ITS instructional programs are not comprised solely of  
2 sectarian instruction or religious worship. ~~and the school~~  
3 ~~participates~~

4 (C) PARTICIPATES in the federal work-study program under  
5 sections 441 to 448 of title IV of the higher education act of  
6 1965, 42 U.S.C. 2751 to 2756b.

7 (D) IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE MICHIGAN CAMPUS SEXUAL ASSAULT  
8 VICTIMS' BILL OF RIGHTS ACT.

9 (2) A participating school, at its option, may offer aca-  
10 demic credit to students enrolled in the MWS program.

11 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
12 Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5624 (request  
13 no. 04665'91) of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
