

HOUSE BILL No. 5662

March 9, 1992, Introduced by Rep. Harrison and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend Act No. 113 of the Public Acts of 1991, entitled

"An act to make appropriations for the department of agriculture for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; to create funds; to provide for the imposition of fees; to require reports, audits, and plans; to authorize certain transfers by certain state agencies; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by certain state agencies,"

by adding section 752; and to repeal certain parts of the act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 113 of the Public Acts of 1991 is amended by
2 adding section 752 to read as follows:

3 Sec. 752. Of the funds appropriated for marketing and market devel-
4 opment, \$500,000.00, shall be spent on world trade promotions of agricul-
5 tural products and commodities. Of the \$500,000.00 for the world trade
6 program, \$100,000.00 shall be for an African trade program and
7 \$150,000.00 shall be for a world trade coordinator.

8 Section 2. Section 751 of Act No. 113 of the Public Acts of 1991 is
9 repealed.
