

HOUSE BILL No. 5671

March 9, 1992, Introduced by Rep. Harrison and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of agriculture for the thoroughbred program for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

1 Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of agriculture

9 GENERAL SECTIONS

10 Sec. 201. (1) In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
 11 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending in
 12 this appropriation act is \$2,020,000.00 and state appropriations to be
 13 paid to local units of government in section 101 are \$0.

14 (2) When it appears to the principal executive officer of each
 15 department that state spending to local units of government will be less
 16 than the amount that was projected to be expended for any quarter, the
 17 principal executive officer shall immediately give notice of the appro-
 18 priate shortfall to the department of management and budget, the senate
 19 and house appropriations committees, and the senate and house fiscal
 20 agencies.

21 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under
 22 this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and
 23 programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to
 24 the management and budget act, Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984,
 25 being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
