- 10 Sec. 201. (1) In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of 11 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending in 12 this appropriation act is \$1,125,000.00 and state appropriations to be 13 paid to local units of government in section 101 are \$0.
- (2) When it appears to the principal executive officer of each
 15 department that state spending to local units of government will be less
 16 than the amount that was projected to be expended for any quarter, the
 17 principal executive officer shall immediately give notice of the appro18 priate shortfall to the department of management and budget, the senate
 19 and house appropriations committees, and the senate and house fiscal
 20 agencies.
- Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to the management and budget act, Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

1 Sec. 301. Included in section 101 is an amount not to exceed 2 \$900,000.00 for promotion of attendance at pari-mutuel horse racing. 3 state funds shall be matched before expenditure such that each \$2.00 of 4 state funds is matched by \$1.00 of private industry funds. A race meet-5 ing licensee or an association of thoroughbred and harness racetracks or 6 any horsemen's group may submit a plan and proposal to the racing commis-7 sioner for use of funds authorized to be expended for promotion of 8 attendance at pari-mutuel horse racing. A plan shall be submitted by the 9 commissioner to the chairpersons of the senate and house subcommittees on 10 agriculture at least 30 days before the funds may be expended. Each 11 licensee or association of thoroughbred and harness racetracks or 12 horsemen's group shall be eligible for promotional funds. Of the amount 13 appropriated in section 101, racing promotion fund, \$225,000.00 shall he 14 allocated by the office of the racing commissioner for on-site promotions 15 at pari-mutuel facilities, county fairs with horse racing, and other 16 appropriate sites which are approved by the racing commissioner. These 17 funds are exempt from the 2-for-1 match required in this section. All 18 unexpended funds shall lapse to the state general fund.
