

HOUSE BILL No. 5685

March 11, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Hood, Scott, Webb, Emerson, Sparks, Oxender, Jacobetti, Owen, Saunders and Bennane and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 15 of Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, entitled as amended "The Michigan liquor control act," being section 436.15 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 15 of Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of
2 the Extra Session of 1933, being section 436.15 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 15. (1) The commission shall have the right and power
5 to buy, have in its possession, and sell in its own name all
6 alcoholic liquor for distribution as provided in sections 13 and
7 14. ~~It shall be the duty of the~~ THE commission ~~to~~ SHALL
8 supply such types of alcoholic liquors as shall be demanded by
9 the public, ~~Provided, however, That~~ EXCEPT THAT if any
10 ~~such~~ brands ~~as~~ THAT are demanded are not manufactured within

1 the borders of the United States or are not readily obtainable
2 within the borders of the United States, then ~~such~~ THOSE orders
3 shall be filled by the commission at the entire expense of the
4 person placing ~~such~~ THE order, plus not less than 46% ~~per~~
5 ~~cent~~ gross profit, subject to any discounts provided for in sec-
6 tion 16. ~~of this act.~~

7 (2) The commission may lease or occupy any building or land
8 required for its operation ~~—~~ and may purchase any warehouse
9 required for its operation, subject to the approval of the state
10 administrative board.

11 (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL MAINTAIN A SYSTEM FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF SPIRITS INVOLVING NOT LESS THAN 75 DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE SAME SIZE AND IN THE SAME LOCATIONS AS
12 TIES IN EXISTENCE ON JANUARY 1, 1992.

15 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DISTRIBUTION FACILITY" MEANS A
16 STORE, WAREHOUSE, OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR TYPE OF FACILITY UTILIZED
17 IN THE DISTRIBUTION OF SPIRITS.
