THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 9 and 10 of Act No. 295 of the Public

- 4 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 9. (1) An EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), AN
- 6 order of income withholding entered under this act shall be
- 7 served on sources of income as provided in section 11. The order
- 8 shall direct sources of income to withhold from income due the

- I payer and to pay to the office of the friend of the court for the
 - 2 judicial circuit in which the order was entered an amount suffi-
 - 3 cient to meet the payments ordered for support and service fees
 - 4 and to defray arrearages in payments and service fees due at
