- 6 OR HER PRIVACY AND CIVIL RIGHTS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
- 7 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- (A) ASSOCIATING WITH INDIVIDUALS OF HIS OR HER CHOICE,
- 2 INCLUDING MEETING PRIVATELY WITH A RELATIVE, FRIEND, OR LEGAL
- 3 COUNSEL.
- (B) SENDING AND RECEIVING PERSONAL MAIL UNOPENED.
- (C) MAKING AND RECEIVING TELEPHONE CALLS.
- (D) ATTENDING A RELIGIOUS SERVICE AND OTHERWISE PRACTICING 7 HIS OR HER RELIGION.
- (E) ATTENDING A SOCIAL GATHERING, CULTURAL EVENT, OR MEETING 9 OF A COMMUNITY GROUP.
- 10 (F) VOTING.
- 11 (G) CHOOSING WHICH OF HIS OR HER CLOTHING TO WEAR AND MAIN-12 TAINING PERSONAL POSSESSIONS.
- (2) WITHIN 7 DAYS AFTER THE APPOINTMENT, AN INDIVIDUAL FOR 13 14 WHOM A GUARDIAN IS APPOINTED SHALL BE INFORMED OF THE PRIVACY AND 15 CIVIL RIGHTS RETAINED UNDER SUBSECTION (1).
