

HOUSE BILL No. 5864

June 1, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Gire, Porreca, Byrum, Scott, Webb, Berman, Johnson, Hollister, Bartnik, Wozniak, Hoffman, Pitoniak, Baade, DeBeaussaert, Harder, Ostling and Stallworth and referred to the Committee on Social Services and Youth.

A bill to amend Act No. 111 of the Public Acts of 1991,
entitled

"An act to make appropriations for the department of social services and certain state purposes related to public welfare services for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; to create funds; to provide for the imposition of fees; to provide for reports; to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the state agency; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain individuals, local governments, and state departments, agencies, and officers,"

by adding section 821.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 111 of the Public Acts of 1991 is
2 amended by adding section 821 to read as follows:

3 SEC. 821. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REINSTATE THE INCOME OFFSET
4 POLICY FOR RECIPIENTS OF AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN,
5 ACCORDING TO THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES USED TO IMPLEMENT THE
6 POLICY IN FEBRUARY, 1992, EXCEPT THAT THE OFFSET SHALL BE LIMITED

1 TO EARNED INCOME. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SEEK ANY FEDERAL WAIVER
2 NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
