

HOUSE BILL No. 5936

June 11, 1992, Introduced by Rep. Ostling and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 217 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled as amended

"The management and budget act,"

as amended by Act No. 504 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 18.1217 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 217 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of
2 1984, as amended by Act No. 504 of the Public Acts of 1988, being
3 section 18.1217 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 217. (1) The department shall issue and administer
6 directives relative to the travel of officers and unclassified
7 employees of state agencies when engaged in the performance of
8 state business and for the reimbursement of expenses necessarily
9 incurred when engaged in the performance of state business from

1 whatever source the reimbursement may be financed. The
2 directives issued pursuant to this section shall not take effect
3 unless the directives are approved by the board.

4 (2) A meeting of a state agency ~~shall~~ MAY be held in ~~a~~
5 ANY facility. ~~owned, leased, being purchased, or operated by~~
6 ~~this state, the federal government, a unit of local government,~~
7 ~~or a state supported institution, college, or university, unless~~
8 ~~the chief executive officer of the state agency, in writing,~~
9 ~~authorizes a different location.~~

10 (3) On January 1 of each year, the director shall prepare a
11 travel report in a format established jointly by the chairpersons
12 of the appropriations committees and shall submit the report to
13 the appropriations committees and the fiscal agencies. The
14 report shall list each person who received compensation, fees, or
15 remuneration under a budget act for travel outside the state
16 during the IMMEDIATELY preceding 12 months. The listing shall
17 include the name of the person who received the compensation,
18 fees, or remuneration and the destination, reason for, and dates
19 of the travel; and the transportation and related costs. The
20 report shall also include a statement of the total in-state
21 travel for the same period.
