- 1 books, records, or accounts which the certified public accountant
- 2 or a person employed by the certified public accountant was
- 3 employed to make. The information derived from or as the result
- 4 of professional service shall be considered confidential and

- 6 (2) This section shall not be construed as prohibiting a
- 7 certified public accountant whose professional competence has
- 8 been challenged in a court of law or before an administrative
- 9 agency from disclosing information otherwise privileged as part
- 10 of a defense to the court action or administrative hearing.
- 11 (3) THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS PROHIBITING THE
