A bill to amend section 722a of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as amended by Act No. 141 of the Public Acts of 1985, being section 257.722a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 722a of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1949, as amended by Act No. 141 of the Public Acts of 1985,
- 3 being section 257.722a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 722a. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 6 section, a truck tractor pulling a semitrailer and trailer combi-
- 7 nation or a truck tractor pulling 2 semitrailers shall not
- 8 transport, except between the hours of midnight to 6 a.m. on
- 9 routes and at times designated by the state fire safety board, a

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- 1 flammable liquid, in bulk, which has a flash point at or below 70
- 2 degrees Fahrenheit within a county having a population of 600,000
- 3 or more. In addition, a truck, a truck pulling a trailer, or a
- 4 truck tractor pulling a semitrailer shall not transport, except
- 5 between the hours of midnight to 6 a.m. on routes and at times
- 6 designated by the state fire safety board, a flammable liquid, in
- 7 bulk, which has a flash point at or below 70 degrees Fahrenheit,
- 8 in a quantity of more than 9,000 gallons within a county having a
- 9 population of 600,000 or more. The exceptions provided by this
- 10 subsection for transport on routes designated by the state fire
- 11 safety board shall be construed to permit that transport only for
- 12 the purpose of picking up or delivering a flammable liquid at a
- 13 supply depot.
- 14 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a
- 15 truck, truck pulling a trailer, truck tractor pulling a semi-
- 16 trailer, a truck tractor pulling a semitrailer and trailer combi-
- 17 nation, or a truck tractor pulling 2 semitrailers shall not
- 18 transport a flammable liquid, in bulk, which has a flash point at
- 19 or below 70 degrees Fahrenheit within this state, unless the
- 20 truck, truck and trailer combination, truck tractor and semi-
- 21 trailer combination, truck tractor, semitrailer, and trailer com-
- 22 bination, or truck tractor and 2 semitrailer combinations meet
- 23 safety standards as determined by the state fire safety board.
- 24 (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a
- 25 truck pulling a trailer, a truck tractor pulling a semitrailer
- 26 and trailer combination, or a truck tractor pulling 2
- 27 semitrailers shall not transport a flammable liquid, in bulk,

- 1 which has a flash point at or below 70 degrees Fahrenheit within
 2 this state. This subsection shall not take effect until November
 3 1, 1990.
- 4 (4) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section
 5 other than subsections (3) and (5), a truck with a water capacity
 6 of more than 9,500 gallons, a truck tractor pulling a semitrailer
 7 with a water capacity of more than 9,500 gallons, a truck pulling
 8 a trailer, a truck tractor pulling a semitrailer and trailer com9 bination, or a truck tractor pulling 2 semitrailers shall not
 10 transport a flammable liquid, in bulk, which has a flash point at
 11 or below 70 degrees Fahrenheit in this state, unless the existing
 12 manhole or inspection ports of each truck, semitrailer, or
 13 trailer in the vehicle combination has been equipped with devices
 14 which are capable of withstanding the forces caused by an inter15 nal pressure of 50 pounds per square inch, applied and held at
 16 least 50 milliseconds, and then released to 2 pounds per square
 17 inch, without having any residual venting of flammable liquid
 18 during the subsequent 2 pounds per square inch condition.
- truck or a truck tractor pulling a semitrailer, a semitrailer and trailer combination, or 2 semitrailers shall not transport a flammable liquid, in bulk, which has a flash point at or below 70 degrees Fahrenheit in this state, if the truck or semitrailer, a semitrailer and trailer combination, or 2 semitrailers are manufactured after July 1, 1982, or was manufactured before July 1, 1982 but was not a vehicle registered in this state by the secretary of state at any time between January 1, 1985 and

(5) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a

- 1 October 1, 1985, unless the truck or the semitrailer, a
- 2 semitrailer and trailer combination, or 2 semitrailers have a
- 3 water capacity of less than 13,800 gallons.
- 4 (6) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a
- 5 truck or truck tractor pulling a semitrailer shall not transport
- 6 a flammable liquid, in bulk, which has a flash point at or below
- 7 70 degrees Fahrenheit in a quantity of more than 13,400 gallons.
- 8 This subsection shall not take effect until November 1, 1990.
- 9 (7) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a
- 10 truck or truck tractor pulling a trailer or semitrailer, a semi-
- II trailer or trailer combination, or 2 semitrailers shall not
- 12 transport a flammable liquid, in bulk, which has a flash point at
- 13 or below 70 degrees Fahrenheit in a quantity of more than 13,400
- 14 gallons unless the owner of the truck or truck tractor pulling
- 15 the trailer or semitrailer, combination semitrailer or trailer,
- 16 or 2 semitrailers files with the department of state police
- 17 within 60 days after -the effective date of this act OCTOBER 31,
- 18 1985 a notarized statement that the truck or truck tractor pull-
- 19 ing the trailer or semitrailer, semitrailer or trailer combina-
- 20 tion, or 2 semitrailers did transport a flammable liquid, in
- 21 bulk, having a flash point at or below 70 degrees Fahrenheit, at
- 22 any time between March 1, 1985 and October 1, 1985. Attached to
- 23 the notarized statement shall be 1 of the following:
- 24 (a) A copy of the bill of lading containing the date the
- 25 flammable liquid was transported and the permanent identification
- 26 number of the trailer or semitrailer in which the flammable
- 27 liquid was transported.

- (b) A copy of the daily log prepared by the driver of thevehicle transporting the flammable liquid which contains the date
- 3 the flammable liquid was transported and the permanent identifi-
- 4 cation number of the trailer or semitrailer in which the flamma-
- 5 ble liquid was transported.
- 6 (8) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A TRUCK TRANSPORTING A
- 7 FLAMMABLE LIQUID, IN BULK, WHICH HAS A FLASH POINT AT OR BELOW 70
- 8 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT WITHIN THIS STATE IF THE TRANSPORT IS IN CON-
- 9 JUNCTION WITH AN EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACTION AUTHORIZED BY THE
- 10 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.
- (9) $\frac{(8)}{(8)}$ The owner or driver of a vehicle which transports
- 12 a flammable liquid in violation of subsection (1), (2), (3), (4),
- 13 (5), (6), or (7) is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine
- 14 of not more than \$3,000.00, or imprisonment for not more than 90
- 15 days, or both.
- 16 (10) -(9) Except as provided in subsection -(8) (9), a
- 17 person who violates this section is responsible for a civil
- 18 infraction.
- 19 (11) $\frac{-(10)}{}$ This section shall be enforced only by a police
- 20 officer.
