## **HOUSE BILL No. 5989**

June 30, 1992, Introduced by Rep. Oxender and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in St. Joseph county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, may convey to the county of St. Joseph, for consideration
- 3 of \$1.00, certain state owned property now under the jurisdiction
- 4 of the department of treasury and located at the St. Joseph
- 5 grange fairgrounds, and more specifically described as follows:
- North 2 feet of the South 50 feet of lots 4, 5, & 6, com-
- 7 mences at the SE Corner of Lot 4, then North 50 feet then East 40
- 8 feet, then South 83.73 feet, then North 86 degrees 48 minutes
- 9 East 41 feet, then North to point of beginning.

- 1 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by
- 2 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general and shall reserve
- 3 to the state all rights to coal, oil, gas, and other mineral
- 4 rights found on or under the property conveyed.
- 5 Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by this act shall provide
- 6 that the property conveyed shall be used for the purpose of con-
- 7 ducting county fairs, and that upon termination of that use, or
- 8 upon use for any other purpose, the property shall revert to the
- 9 state, with the state assuming no liability for any improvements
- 10 made by the county of St. Joseph or by any other person or
- 11 entity.
- 12 Sec. 4. The revenue derived from the conveyance authorized
- 13 under this act shall be deposited with the state treasurer and
- 14 credited to the general fund.
