

HOUSE BILL No. 6004

July 8, 1992, Introduced by Rep. Profit and referred to the Committee on Judiciary,

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 380a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 380a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 380A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT DO EITHER OF THE
5 FOLLOWING:

6 (A) MALICIOUSLY DAMAGE OR DESTROY A MAILBOX.

7 (B) MALICIOUSLY DAMAGE OR DESTROY A DEVICE USED TO SUPPORT A
8 MAILBOX.

1 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
2 CRIME AS FOLLOWS:

3 (A) IF THE DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION IS \$100.00 OR LESS, THE
4 PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR
5 NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$100.00, OR
6 BOTH.

7 (B) IF THE DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION IS MORE THAN \$100.00, THE
8 PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT
9 MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR BOTH.

10 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "MAILBOX" MEANS A RECEPTACLE
11 USED OR INTENDED TO BE USED FOR SENDING OR RECEIVING MAIL THROUGH
12 THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE.
