

HOUSE BILL No. 6009

July 22, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Oxender, Nye, Gnodtke, McNutt, Bobier, Van Singel, Dalman, Walberg, Sparks, Sikkema, Gernaat, Hoekman, Bodem and Bender and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend section 802 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as amended by Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1989, being section 257.802 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 802 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
2 1949, as amended by Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1989, being
3 section 257.802 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 802. (1) For a special registration issued as provided
6 for in section 226(8), there shall be paid 1/2 the tax imposed
7 under section 801 and in addition a fee of \$10.00. The fee shall
8 be credited to the Michigan transportation fund and used to
9 defray the expenses of the special registration.

1 (2) For all commercial vehicles registered after August 31
2 for the period expiring the last day of February and all motorcy-
3 cles registered after September 30 for the period expiring on the
4 last day of March, a tax of 1/2 the rate otherwise imposed by
5 this act shall be collected. This subsection is not applicable
6 to vehicles registered by manufacturers or dealers under
7 sections 244 to 247a.

8 (3) For each special registration as provided for in section
9 226(9), a fee of \$5.00 shall be collected. The fee shall be
10 credited to the Michigan transportation fund and used to defray
11 the expenses of the special registrations.

12 (4) For temporary registration plates or markers as provided
13 for in section 226a(1), a fee of \$5.00 for each group of 5 of
14 those temporary registration plates or markers shall be
15 collected. The fee shall be credited to the Michigan transporta-
16 tion fund and used to defray the expenses of the temporary regis-
17 tration plates or markers.

18 (5) A fee of \$5.00 shall be collected for each temporary
19 registration as provided for in section 226b, the fee to be cred-
20 ited to the Michigan transportation fund and used to defray the
21 expenses of the temporary registrations.

22 (6) For registration plates as provided for in section
23 226a(5), (6), and (7), a fee of \$40.00 for 2 registration plates
24 and \$20.00 for each additional registration plate shall be
25 collected. The fee shall be credited to the Michigan transporta-
26 tion fund and used to defray the expenses of the temporary plates
27 or markers.

1 (7) For special registrations issued for special mobile
2 equipment as provided in section 216(d), a fee of \$15.00 each for
3 the first 3 special registrations, and \$5.00 for each special
4 registration issued in excess of the first 3 shall be collected.
5 The fee shall be credited to the Michigan transportation fund and
6 used to defray the expenses of the plates or markers.

7 (8) The secretary of state, upon request, may issue a regis-
8 tration valid for 3 months for use on a vehicle with an elected
9 gross weight of 24,000 pounds or greater on the payment of 1/4
10 the full registration fee provided in section 801(1)(k) and in
11 addition a service charge of \$10.00. The service charge shall be
12 credited to the Michigan transportation fund and used to defray
13 the expense of the registration plates or tabs.

14 (9) Upon application to the secretary of state, an owner of
15 a truck, truck tractor, or road tractor which is used exclusively
16 for the purpose of gratuitously transporting farm crops between
17 the field where produced and the place of storage or used to
18 transport fertilizer, seed or spray material from the farm loca-
19 tion to the field may obtain a special registration. The fee for
20 each special registration shall be \$15.00. The fee shall be
21 credited to the Michigan transportation fund and used to defray
22 the expenses of the special registration program. The special
23 registration shall be valid for a period of up to 12 months and
24 shall expire on December 31.

25 (10) The secretary of state, upon request, may issue a spe-
26 cial registration valid for 3 or more months for a road tractor,
27 truck, or truck tractor owned by a farmer, if the motor vehicle

1 is used exclusively in connection with the farmer's farming
2 operations or for the transportation of the farmer and the
3 farmer's family and not used for hire. The fee for the registra-
4 tion shall be 1/10 of the fee provided in section 801(1)(c) times
5 the number of months for which the special registration is
6 requested and, in addition, a service fee of \$10.00. The fee
7 shall be credited to the Michigan transportation fund and used to
8 defray the expenses of the registration. No special registration
9 shall be issued for a motor vehicle for which the fee under sec-
10 tion 801(1)(c) would be less than \$50.00.

11 (11) The secretary of state, upon request, may issue a reg-
12 istration valid for 3 months or more for use on a vehicle with an
13 elected gross weight of 24,000 pounds or greater. The fee for
14 the registration shall be 1/10 of the fee provided in
15 section 801(1)(k), times the number of months for which the spe-
16 cial registration is requested and, in addition, a service fee of
17 \$10.00. The fee shall be credited to the Michigan transportation
18 fund and used to defray the expenses of the registration.

19 (12) For each special registration as provided for in
20 section 226(12), a fee of \$10.00 shall be collected. The fee
21 shall be credited to the Michigan transportation fund and used to
22 defray the expenses of the special registrations.

23 (13) UPON APPLICATION TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AN OWNER OF
24 A VEHICLE USED EXCLUSIVELY TO TRANSPORT RECYCLABLE MATERIALS TO
25 OR FROM A RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY MAY OBTAIN A SPECIAL
26 REGISTRATION. THE FEE FOR EACH SPECIAL REGISTRATION SHALL BE
27 \$15.00. THE FEE SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE MICHIGAN TRANSPORTATION

1 FUND AND USED TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE SPECIAL
2 REGISTRATION. THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION SHALL BE VALID FOR A
3 PERIOD OF UP TO 12 MONTHS AND SHALL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31. AS
4 USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "RECYCLABLE MATERIALS" AND "RESOURCE
5 RECOVERY FACILITY" HAVE THE MEANINGS ATTRIBUTED TO THESE TERMS IN
6 THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT, ACT NO. 641 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF
7 1978, BEING SECTIONS 299.401 TO 299.437 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED
8 LAWS, EXCEPT THAT THE TERM RECYCLABLE MATERIALS DOES NOT INCLUDE
9 INDUSTRIAL SCRAP METAL.
