- 5 Sec. 3. (1) A minor shall not be employed in, about, or in

- 7 rious to the minor's health or personal well-being or which
- 8 THAT is contrary to standards established pursuant to this act
- 9 unless a deviation is granted under section 20.

- 1 (2) The minimum age for employment of minors is 14 years. —,
  2 except that HOWEVER, a minor 11 years of age or older may be
- 3 employed as a golf caddy; A MINOR 11 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER MAY BE
- 4 EMPLOYED BY A CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP RECREATION DEPARTMENT AS
- 5 A SCOREKEEPER, REFEREE, UMPIRE, OR RECREATIONAL EMPLOYEE IF THE
- 6 EMPLOYMENT DOES NOT EXCEED 20 HOURS A WEEK; and a minor 13 years
- 7 of age or older may be employed in farming operations as
- 8 described in section 4(3).
