A bill to amend sections 474, 475, 476, and 477 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, entitled "Michigan election law,"

being sections 168.474, 168.475, 168.476, and 168.477 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 474, 475, 476, and 477 of Act No. 116
