A bill to provide for the designation of a dark sky preserve; to regulate certain activities within a dark sky preserve; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Commission" means the commission of natural resources.
- 3 (b) "Dark sky preserve" means the area designated in section

- 5 (c) "Fully shielded" means outdoor light fixtures shielded
- 6 or constructed so that no light rays are emitted by the installed
- 7 fixture at angles above 15 degrees below the horizontal plane as
- 8 certified by a photometric test report, and also constructed so
- 9 that the filament or light source is not visible to the naked eye

- 3 Sec. 2. The state owned land at Lake Hudson, legally

- 5 All state-owned land located in Sections 25, 26, 27, 34, 35,

- 8 is designated a dark sky preserve.
- 9 Sec. 3. (1) The commission shall ensure that outdoor light-

- 24 (c) Wherever practical, lighting fixtures shall be motion
- 25 sensor fixtures, and not fixtures that remain lighted during all
- 26 hours of darkness.
