A bill to create certain ethics commissions within the legislature; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain commissions and commissioners; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain other persons.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2 "legislative ethics act".
- 3 Sec. 3. (1) The ethics commission of the house of represen-
