

# HOUSE BILL No. 6216

November 18, 1992, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to provide for a picture on an identification card of individuals holding certain occupational licenses under certain circumstances; and to provide for certain powers and duties for certain state agencies.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2       (a) "License" means a certificate, registration, or license  
3 issued by an occupational regulatory agency which allows an indi-  
4 vidual to engage in a regulated occupation or which allows an  
5 individual to use a specific title in the practice of an occupa-  
6 tion, profession, or vocation.

7       (b) "Occupational regulatory agency" means a department,  
8 bureau, or agency of the state of Michigan that has regulatory  
9 authority over a regulated occupation.

1 (c) "Regulated occupation" means an occupation, profession,  
2 or vocation which requires a license as a predicate for the  
3 practice of the occupation, profession, or vocation or for the  
4 use of a specific title in the practice of the occupation, pro-  
5 fession, or vocation.

6 Sec. 2. An occupational regulatory agency which issues an  
7 identification card to an individual holding a license for a reg-  
8 ulated occupation shall provide for a picture of the licensed  
9 individual on the identification card.
